### RIDER SIGN ON AND MACHINE EXAMINATION:

#### ALL JUNIORS & SENIORS

**Sand / Paddle Tyres are not be used at these events**

All riders must complete the electronic self-scrutineering form **prior** to **12pm Friday the 14<sup>th</sup> July**, either via <https://www.saoffroadchampionships.com/self-scrutineering/> or via the link on the Facebook page.

*If you do not complete the online self-scrutineering form, you will need to present your bike complete and ready for racing, helmet and boots to the Chief Scrutineers and their assistants during sign on.*

You may be required to present your MA Licence and Junior logbook for inspection. Your RIDERNET Virtual Card is acceptable. Download the RIDERNET App if you haven't already.

If you are unable to present your MA Licence if required, you will forfeit your entry in this event.

Machines must comply with the MOMS requirements and the Series Supplementary Regulations.

**Random machine examinations will occur throughout the weekend by the Chief Scrutineer and their assistants.**

Junior and Senior riders will need to present the following items for Random Machine Examination immediately at the request of the Chief Scrutineer or his assistants:

- Your helmet and boots.
- Your bike complete and ready for racing with correct numbers on all **three** plates.

**All numbers must be your registered SA ENDURO number as indicated on your Ridernet Profile/License.**

### TIMING:

**The Race Results system will be used for timing.**

New Timing Tags will be issued at sign on, please remove all old tags prior to arriving at the venue.

Instructions will be included on how and where to put the tags.

**All riders are required to push their bike through the "tag check" prior to racing.**

#### TRACK & PITS:

Open undulating country consisting of soft sand and heavy loam, with scrubby mallee sections consisting of a mixture of sand, clay and limestone.

All competitors are to follow the marked course which is identified by arrows and bunting.

**Pit Space-** The main race line through the pits has been clearly defined by orange bollards and painted lines, a minimum of 2m is to be left either side of this as a transit lane. Pit tents only on the transition lane, all caravans and trailers to be a minimum 6m back from the transition lane.

**Note:** All competitors will be utilizing the same pit area.

#### TRACK ACCESS:

- **Friday 14th July** - Pits open from 12pm. Tracks open to walk from 2.00pm.
- You may only walk, no pushbikes – penalties apply.

#### SIGN ON - TIME SCHEDULE:

- **Friday 14th July** – Senior & Junior early bird Sign on 3pm till 5pm.
- **Saturday 15th July** – Junior Sign on 6.00 am till 7.10am.
- **Saturday 15th July** – Senior Sign on 10.00am till 11.00am.
- **Sunday 16th July** – Junior & Senior Sign on 7.00am till 7.30 am (riders who have entered for Rnd 2 only).

#### FORMAT:

**Saturday 15th** - will be a Cross Country, in three separate races, of the duration below.

- Race 1 - JUNIOR (JJ & J1) – (5kms approx) – Duration 1.5 Hours includes sight lap.
- Race 2 - JUNIOR (J2, J3, J4) – (10kms approx) - Cross Country – Duration 2 Hours includes sight lap.
- Race 3 - SENIORS - Cross Country – (14kms approx) - Duration 3 Hours includes sight lap.

**Sunday 16th** – will be a sprint format, with all classes racing all day.

- Paint Tech Test - JUNIOR Sprints – (5kms approx) - Start Sprint - will remain on the same course all day.
- WSB Distributors Test - SENIORS Sprints – (8kms approx) - Start Sprint - will remain on the same course all day.

**Race 1 – JJ & J1** riders will be led out by a sweep rider and with a sweep rider behind them.

**There will be NO over taking any sweep riders PENALIES APPLY.**

*Sight lap – After the **final** sweep has completed the course including the pits the race will start in 5 minutes (No exceptions).*

**START RACE** - Start one Row at a time with 1 Minute between Rows Starting

- 1st Row – J1 Riders lined up in a Single Row
- 2nd Row – JJ Riders lined up in a Single Row

**Note – Dead Engine Start – Hands on bars.**



9.15am Race Finish, Sweep Course

9.30am\* **Race 2 – J2, J3, J4** riders will be led out by a sweep rider and with a sweep rider behind them.

**There will be NO over taking any sweep riders PENALIES APPLY.**

*Sight lap – After the **final** sweep has completed the course including the pits the race will start in 5 minutes (No exceptions).*

**START RACE** - Start one Row at a time with 1 Minute between Rows Starting

- 1st Row - J4 Riders lined up in a Single Row
- 2nd Row – J3 Riders lined up in a Single Row
- 3rd Row – J2 Riders lined up in a Single Row

**Note – Dead Engine Start – Hands on bars.**

### SENIORS

11:30am **Compulsory SENIOR Rider briefing**

12:15pm\* **Race 3 –** riders will be led out by a sweep rider and with a sweep rider behind them.  
*Notice to all riders: the sight lap entry will close 10 minutes after the lead sweep rider leaves, be ready for sight lap.*

**There will be NO over taking any sweep riders PENALIES APPLY.**

*Sight lap – After the **final** sweep has completed the course including the pits the race will start in 10 minutes (No exceptions).*

**START RACE** - Start one Row at a time with 1 Minute between Rows Starting

- 1st Row PRO/Expert
- 2nd Row C3
- 3rd Row C2
- 4th Row C1
- 5th Row Vet
- 6th Row Mas/Women

**Note – Dead Engine Start – Hands on bars.**

Sign on and machine examination (all Classes) for all riders who did not compete on Saturday or who have changed bikes.

**8:00am**

**Compulsory Rider Briefing** (ALL Junior and Senior riders)

**8:15am**

*Sight lap (All classes) – After the **final** sweep has completed the course including the pits the race will start in 10 minutes (No exceptions).*

**There will be NO over taking any sweep riders penalties apply.**

**8:30 – 3:30pm**

**Sprints**

- Paint Tech Test - JUNIOR Sprints - Start Sprint
  - WSB Distributors Test - SENIORS Sprints – Start Sprint
- Riders will complete as many heats as instructed by the Clerk of Course.

**CATERING:** Catering will be provided by:

**TOLIETS & SHOWERS:** Toilets and Hot Showers are available at the venue. Please respect them and if they require restocking or cleaning, please let a KDMCC committee member know.

**CAMPING:** Available from Friday at the track. It is requested that a \$10.00 donation (family/carload) is made for camping at sign on.

**CAMP FIRES:** Fires are permitted provided they are in a suitable container (e.g., brazier or tub). Please bring your own fire wood. **All fires must be out during racing.** Gas cookers are allowed.

**RUBBISH:** Please take all rubbish home with you.

**MOBILE COVERAGE:** Telstra is good, other networks are limited.

**FIRSTCARE MEDICAL:** Has been organised for the event and will be in-attendance from 7.45 am on race days.

**FUEL & NOISE TESTING:** Fuel and noise testing may take place at random.

**ENVIROMATS:** Are **Compulsory** and must be used when re-fuelling, oiling chains etc. These are available at Sign On for \$10. each; penalties will apply as per the Supplementary Regulations for breach of this requirement.

It is recommended that enviromats be replaced for each event. At the very least, ensure that they are cleaned thoroughly as they are very good at attaching weed seeds and we don't want weed seeds spread between properties.

**GOGGLE TEAR OFFS:** are not permitted to be used at this event as per of the 2023 MOMS General Competition Rules.



**DOGS & FOOTWEAR:** Please note: Animals (except human aid dogs) and Push Bikes are **NOT** permitted at the event at all. Penalties apply. NO open footwear.

**FIRE EXTINGUISHERS:** Riders are required to have at least one: 2kg dry powder A:B (E) class charged and tagged fire extinguisher clearly visible and available to the rider/pit crew at all time in the re-fuel area.

**BIO-SECURITY ALERT:**

Please keep to designated roadways (marked in yellow on the property map below) and **do not enter** any area other than that designated to the SAORC as some areas of the property are restricted quarantine areas.

Please **DO NOT** bring any pests or weed seeds onto the property.

Please be respectful to the landholder and their livelihood.

**OTHER NOTES:**

Please advise the Clerk of Course if you are not continuing to compete at a round.

All Injuries must be reported to the Clerk of Course.
