# **ELECTRONIC SELF SCRUTINEERING & MACHINE EXAMINATION:**

#### **ALL JUNIORS & SENIORS**

Electronic Self Scrutineering must be completed on the SAORC website and must be completed prior to arriving at the venue. https://www.saoffroadchampionships.com/self-scrutineering/

Machines must comply with the MOMS requirements and championship Supplementary Regulations. Paddle style tyres are not permitted at this venue.

Random machine examinations will occur throughout the weekend by the Chief Scrutineer and their assistants.

NUMBERS - Your bike must display correct numbers on all three plates. (Your State issued Enduro Number)

#### **BACKUP TIMERS**

In the absence of sufficient back up timers, riders will be required to nominate a backup timer to assist on either for a couple of hours. Time slots will be allocated during rider sign on and a briefing provided to those assisting.

#### TRACK:

The course consists of pine forest, tight trees and technical log sections with bypasses sections. All competitors are to follow the marked course which is identified by arrows and bunting.

The length of each lap is approximately:

- Nutrien Ag Junior Test JJ & J1 -2.2km
- Nutrien Ag Junior Test J2-J4 4.5km
- Yamaha Pitmans Senior Test -6.7km

#### **TIMING TAGS & RACE RESULTS:**

### Test times will be recorded by Race results.

All riders will be given 2 x Race timing tags, you will need to collect new tags at sign on for the 2025 season. Any previously used Race results tags will need to be removed.

All riders <u>MUST</u> push their bike through the "Tag Check" prior to racing. Failure to correctly apply tags may result in no or missing race times. It is the riders responsibility to ensure tags are applied correctly and tested via the Tag Check prior to racing.

# **RIDERS BRIEFING (COMPULSORY)**

All riders (parent or guardian if under 18 years) must attend, there will be a random roll call, and any competitor not present will be fined.

**CAMP FIRES:** Fires are not permitted due to the dry conditions.

**RUBBISH:** All rubbish to be taken home

**MOBILE COVERAGE:** Is Ok

FIRSTCARE MEDICAL: has been organised for the event and will be in-attendance from 7.30 am on race day.

**FUEL & NOISE TESTING:** Fuel and noise testing may take place at random.

**ENVIROMATS:** Are Compulsory and must be used when re-fuelling, oiling chains etc. These are available at Sign On for \$10. each; penalties will apply as per the Supplementary Regulations for breach of this requirement.

**GOGGLE TEAR OFFS:** are not permitted to be used at this event as per of the 2025 MOMS General Competition Rules.

**DOGS & FOOTWEAR:** Please note: Animals (except human aid dogs) and Push Bikes are NOT permitted at the event. NO open footwear.

**FIRE EXTINGUISHERS:** Riders are required to have at least one: 2kg dry powder A:B (E) class charged and tagged fire extinguisher clearly visible and available to the rider/pit crew at all time in the re-fuel area.

## **OTHER NOTES:**

- Please advise the Clerk of Course or Race Secretary if you are not continuing to compete at a round. All Injuries must be reported to the Clerk of Course.
- Please leave all pushbikes and pets at home






# MAP TO VENUE
