Electronic self-scrutineering & machine examination

All Juniors & Seniors

Electronic Self-Scrutineering must be completed at this link: <https://www.saoffroadchampionships.com/self-scrutineering/> prior to arriving at the event. Machines must comply with the MOMS requirements and championship Supplementary Regulations. Paddle/ sand tyres may be used at this event.

Random machine examinations will take place throughout the weekend by the Technical Officer and their assistants.

NUMBERS - Your bike must display correct numbers on all three plates. (Your State issued Enduro Number)

Backup Timers

Riders will be required to nominate a backup timer to assist for a couple of hours. Time slots will be allocated during rider sign on and a briefing provided to those assisting.

Track

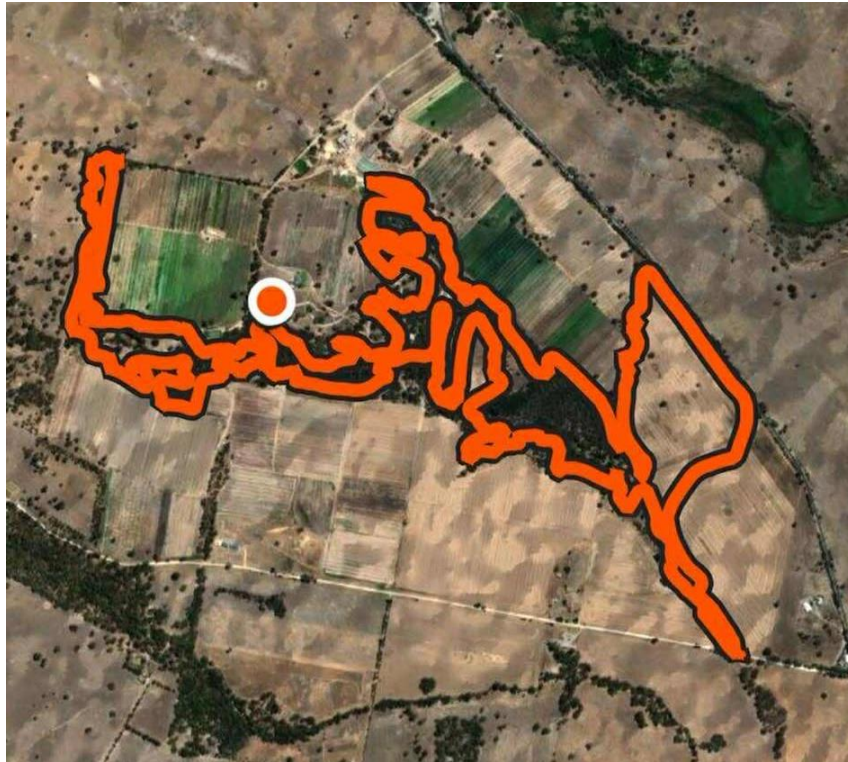
The course consists of open flowing sandy tracks, sandy motorcross track, technical scrub sections and grass track. All competitors are to follow the marked course which is identified by arrows and bunting.

The length of each full lap is approximately 14km's. JJ & J1 will ride a shortened variant approx. 6kms. J2,3,4, JG will ride a variant approx. 10kms. With Seniors riding the full course of 14km's.

Rider Briefing (compulsory)

All riders (parent or guardian if under 18years) must attend, there will be a random roll call, and any competitor not present will be fined.

ALL Riders must read the SAORC Round 8 2025 Riders Briefing Notes on the SAORC Website prior to attending. Riders Briefing is a **NO SMOKING** area.



Property Entrance

Access to the pit area involves a short commute through paddocks. A track has been mowed through the crop courtesy of the farmer. Please stick to the marked track. Road rules apply keep to the left and be cautious of 2 way traffic. Any damage to crops will not be tolerated.

Timing tags & race results

Test times will be recorded by Race results.

All riders will be given 2 x Race timing tags, you will need to collect new tags at sign on for the 2025 season. Any previously used Race results tags **MUST** be removed.

All riders **MUST** push their bike through the "Tag Check" prior to racing. Failure to correctly apply tags may result in no or missing race times. It is the riders responsibility to ensure tags are applied correctly and tested via the Tag Check prior to racing.

Catering

Camping

Camp fires

Fires are permitted, bring your own firewood, collection of firewood on the property is prohibited.

Rubbish

All rubbish is to be taken home with you.

Mobile reception

Mobile phone reception is ok at the property.

Medical

First care medical will be on site from 07:30 on Saturday.

Fuel & noise testing

Competitors machines may be selected at random for fuel and noise testing.

Enviromats

Are Compulsory and must be used when refueling, oiling chains etc. These are available at Sign On for \$10. each; penalties will apply as per the Supplementary Regulations for breach of this requirement. EFTPOS will be available.

Goggle tear offs

are not permitted to be used at this event as per the 2025 MOMS General Competition Rules.

Dogs & footwear

Please note: Animals (except human aid dogs) and Push Bikes are NOT permitted at the event. NO open footwear.

Spectators

There will be a designated spectator area at the event. Spectator access to other parts of the event will be prohibited and penalties may apply.

Fire extinguishers

Riders are required to have at least one charged and tagged 2kg dry powder A:B (E) class fire extinguisher, clearly visible and available to the rider/pit crew at all times in the refueling area.

- Please advise the Clerk of Course or Race Secretary if you are not continuing to compete at a round. All Injuries must be reported to the Clerk of Course.
- Please leave all pushbikes and pets at home
